City of Baudette Regular Council Meeting Monday, April 10, 2023, 5:00 p.m. Council Chambers

I. Call to Order

Mayor Rone called the meeting to order at 5 p.m. Present were council persons Cole Nelson, Ben Davidson, Steve Johnson and Steve Theis, Jr.

Staff Members present: Clerk/Treasurer Tina Rennemo, Liquor Store Manager Erica Anderson, Library Director Kelli Pelland, Utility Superintendent Roger Schotl and Fire Chief Brad Levasseur.

II. Pledge of Allegiance

Meeting was streamed live on the city website.

III. Approve Agenda

Motion by S. Johnson, second by C. Nelson to approve the agenda with the addition of 7a. Resignation of Water Operator. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. Public Hearings

1. Small Cities Development Application

Public hearing opened at 5:05. John Butenhoff, Kristi Hasbargen and Heather Hartnell appeared on behalf of the Baudette Housing Authority. No residents appeared to provide feedback on the Small Cities Grant application submission. Motion by S. Johnson, second by B. Davidson to close the hearing at 6 p.m.

VII. Staff Reports

1. Finance

The 2022 audit is complete—auditor Colleen Hoffman will attend the May 8 council meeting to present the findings to the city council.

2. Library

Pelland reported that she filled 70 Easter eggs for the Chamber Easter egg hunt and received a donation of \$1,000 from the United Way for the Summer Reading program. Pelland added that the library will host an author next week.

3. Zoning

Eaton reported that the ordinance draft for lot development was submitted to the city attorney for review. Eaton requested feedback on the annual city spring tour.

4. Liquor

Anderson reported the software upgrade is ongoing, she is working on signage quotes, they have added new food items and are working on lighting and boiler issues at Westside.

Mayor Rone commended Anderson on her work with the Chamber and the successful Easter Egg Hunt.

5. Parks Recreation/Cemetery

Rone asked about the status of the beach project.

6. Streets/Utilities/Buildings

Dani and Nick Abel appeared to discuss parking on Main Street with regard to the members of the fitness center. Mayor Rone indicated that the city is willing to work with the property owners to find a solution—noting, the residents of the apartments need to find off-street parking. The streets committee will meet with Schotl to discuss options—with summer the parking lot across the street will provide a solution.

Schotl reported that the control panel at the wells will be replaced tomorrow, the water leak on Main Street will be excavated tomorrow. Brian Grund reported three bids were received on the 2023 paving project (3rd Avenue NE, 3rd Street and 2nd Street SE) have been opened and the low bid is \$40,000 under the engineers estimate. Motion by S. Johnson, seconded by C. Nelson to accept the bid from Agassiz Asphalt for \$123,150.00 for the 2022 paving project. Motion carried unanimously.

Grund indicated that KGM will be back to finish the punch list items—including the planters—in the near future. Grund gave a brief update on the liquidated damages on the Main Avenue N project which will be exchanged for patching.

Grund shared that the SCDP grant addresses the water and sewer issues, adds storm sewer infrastructure which are the city portion. It also addresses private sewer lines and widens the streets—the housing portion.

7. Personnel

a. Resignation of Water Operator—Lucas Armstrong

Motion by S. Nelson, second by S. Johnson to accept the resignation of Lucas Armstrong—date to be determined by the Utility Superintendent. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Fire Department

Levasseur reported the department will be celebrating two retirements—Ken Larson and Jerry Pirkl—they have over 80 years of service combined. In addition, the department has some landing zone training scheduled, hose testing on the agenda, a June 17 hazmat training and on June 3rd the annual pancake breakfast and a house burn training.

9. Airport Commission

The terminal renovation project is complete---with the exception of the bathrooms.

VIII. Old Business

1. Criminal Defense Attorney

Rennemo reported that Joe Boyle is not interested in criminal defense. The next step is negotiating with the County for services.

I. Call to Order

Meeting was streamed live to the website.

II. Pledge of Allegiance

III. Public Forum

1. Bake of the Woods Bakery—Food Truck Fees

Julia and Alex attended to address the council with regard to fees and license limits placed on food trucks within the city limits. Mayor Rone indicated that the city will do some research and act on potential changes at the May council meeting. Options to consider will be not counting licenses issued for Sundays—as the local restaurants are closed—a lower rate for city residents. Rennemo will follow up with the city attorney.

IV. Staff Reports

1. Finance

2. Library

Pelland reported that another author visit has been scheduled, Mental Health Awareness month--hosting an open house on Wednesday from 3:30-5:30 with a speaker at 4:30. Pelland added that there may be an opening on the library board.

3. Zoning

Eaton reported on the current projects—Lakes Gas demolition and the annual ride-around scheduled for May 18 at 5 p.m.

a. Old Nursing Home Update

Rennemo shared research on the options for mitigating the hazardous building located at 410 3rd Avenue SE—1) MN Statute 463 sue the property owner under the hazardous property statute—demand that all steps to bring the building into compliance or the building is removed by a specific date, if not completed the city would complete and request a court order to assess costs to owner 2) Enter a demolition contract with the city—the city pays for the demolition upfront and assesses to the tax rolls, or 3) MN Statute 117 condemn the structure and pursue eminent domain channels to acquire and redevelop the property—the city would pay property owner the fair market value of the property less demolition costs.

4. Liquor

Anderson shared that they have completed some maintenance and software updates on the ATM and will continue to test it. The POS software update is going well and the application for liquor permits for the 3rd and 4th will be presented at the next meeting.

5. Parks/Cemetery

a. Bike Upgrade

Rennemo presented a bid for \$5,280 to upgrade the bikes at Timber Mill Park. Council discussed putting the bikes in two locations. Mayor Rone suggested contacting Tony at HRDC about some Carbon Caption grant money. Rennemo will follow up—action will be added to the May council meeting.

6. Streets/Building/Utilities

a. Stop Sign Installation—4th Ave SE and 2nd Street NE

Schotl reported complaints on the speed of traffic and requests for a 4 way stop—council declined and suggested working with the Sheriff's Office for speed control.

b. Flags on Main Avenue North and South

Schotl commented on the need for replacements and potentially extending the flags to the south as the street lights match and are an extension of the north side—adding that the cost is higher than in the past. Mayor Rone suggested checking the Legion catalog website-- for very reasonable prices.

c. Parking on 1st Street SE

Schotl asked council to consider additional options for the parking situation—the parking only on the west side is not addressing the issues of the department.

d. Power Pole Inspections and Resistance Testing

Schotl presented a bid to complete the inspections and testing on all of the electric poles for \$7,000—the maintenance has not been performed for 3 years and was previously on a 2-year cycle. Council authorized Schotl to proceed with scheduling the work.

Other Updates

Schotl is working with MN Rural Water Association to address the hydrant damage from the failure to complete seasonal maintenance last fall—there are 23-24 hydrants that need repairs and at least 5 with broken barrels—estimated replacements \$30,000 plus the excavation costs. MRWA will assist in the repairs—Schotl plans to tackle it in two teams. The new panel is in and working—there is still water "missing" approximately 21,000 gallons daily and the crew continues to search for the leak. Two leaks have been located and residents are being served with temporary water from neighbors—Schotl reported that a letter to Lyle and Laya Nelson will be drafted to outline the expectations for the property with regard to the training burn exercise as well at the other violations on the property—establishing a deadline for completion or consequences for non-compliance. Four part-time employees have been offered positions for the summer season—Terry Nelson, Charlie Eck, Jacob Martin and Kurt Nuss.

7. Personnel

8. Fire

Rone reported that there is grant money available for small fire departments.

9. Airport

The next project will be the seaplane base—bids are on hold to determine who wins the bid for the paving work in town.

V. NEW BUSINESS

1. Vacancy on the HRA Board—John Butenhof

Rennemo reported that John submitted his resignation but was continuing until an executive director is hired. C. Nelson updated the council on several concerns about the hiring process and the interview panel for the HRA executive director.

2. MBC Code Update

Rennemo advised the council that the new edition of the MBC has been released—the primary updates are to the nuisance and peddlers/solicitors chapters as well as liquor licensing legislative changes. The storm water drainage utility and bicycle chapters were removed—OML, emergency management, traffic regulations and dangerous dog provisions were condensed. The background checks on employees and license applicant provision were removed. Rennemo will review the additional revisions and report back.

3. HRA Agreement for Engineering Services

Motion by S. Johnson, second by B. Davidson to approve the agreement and authorize Mayor Rone to sign—for the sharing of engineering services on the Westwood Project. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

a. Contract for Criminal Attorney Prosecution (8a.m.)

Jim Austad attended to stress to the council the urgency for the city to appoint an attorney—sharing that the judge has talked with him and is getting frustrated—Austad shared that there is a possibility that the cases could be "dismissed" if there isn't an attorney to prosecute. Austad advised the council that the city has between 5-10 cases on average. Austad agreed to represent the city for no charge until June 30th. Motion by S. Johnson, second by C. Nelson to appoint Jim Austad interim criminal defense attorney not to exceed June 30th. Motion carried unanimously.

VII. NOTICES AND COMMUNICATIONS

a. HRA Director Position—Update

C. Nelson updated the council—consensus was that two people exiting the HRA organization should not be the only two individuals sitting on the hiring committee.

Mayor Rone reported that the HRFC has \$2.3 million dollars to loan out ASAP—invite those business members that may be able to use the funds to apply.

Below is a proposal for appraisal services from Ann Heimbach. \$5,000 for an appraisal is fairly standard given it is what is provided in the condemnation statute as reimbursement for property owner's appraisal costs. (Single family residential properties and duplexes are reimbursed up to \$1,500 and everything else is \$5,000.)

Ann said she has testified in commissioners hearings before, and is willing to do so. Her blended rate for prep and testimony is not on the low end, but it is not out of the ordinary for an appraiser with her qualifications.

Timing wise: 5-6 weeks for completion is good based on what I've seen lately. A lot of them are taking significantly longer than this.

Thank you for sending the details. I could complete an appraisal of the property for a fee of \$5,000. Testimony and preparation, if needed, would be billed separately at \$250 per hour. Timing for completion is 5 to 6 weeks currently.

The report would be a fully documented appraisal report in conformance with USPAP. It would include the value of the land as if vacant which would require an estimate of demolition costs as one approach and would include the value of the property as improved based on regional sales data of properties purchased for conversion to other uses as another approach.
